Dr. Prakash K. Nair (Professor of Organizational Behavior and Leadership MYRA(Mysore Royal Academy, School of Business) was the resource person for the said event, briefed our Degree students (BCA and BCOM) on various learning aspects.

Dr. Prakash K. Nair is Associate Dean and accomplished leadership development professional at Infosys, Texas A & M, and Singer India limited. He has trained and coached several hundred employees and managers.

He highlighted the Big Five Personality Traits as under:

Many contemporary personality psychologists believe that there are five basic dimensions of personality, often referred to as the "Big 5" personality traits. The five broad personality traits described by the theory are extraversion (also often spelled extroversion), agreeableness, openness, conscientiousness, and neuroticism. These five categories are usually described as follows.

Openness: People who are high in this trait tend to be more adventurous and creative. People low in this trait are often much more traditional and may struggle with abstract thinking.

Conscientiousness: If you are high on this extremely important personality trait, you are actually a goal-oriented person. You have exceptional pulse control with highest levels of thoughtfulness.

Extraversion: Extroverts are highly energetic, enthusiastic and easily visible to people around them. They like to take action and see results no matter whatever it takes. They are often the conversation starters in social gatherings and like to be the center of attraction as well.

Agreeableness: Agreeable people are some of the best people you would ever meet. They are affectionate, kind, full of empathy for others and extremely trustable. They are very helpful, generous and considerate. They can even compromise their own interests in order for you to get what you want.

Neuroticism: Neuroticism is the last and yet another important trait of the Big Five Personality Traits Model. Some of the important characteristics of neuroticism are emotional instability, sulkiness and unhappiness.
